Boarding Weekend Activities	Invoiced as part of termly invoice £750 per term – If students Flexi Board at the weekend a cost of £50.00 including the Weekend activity or excursion.
External examination/assessment fees	Invoiced separately as incurred and instructed.



GCSE Exam materials	Where these are bespoke a cost will be associated with these.
School bus:	This service offers our parents and carers the reassurance of travel to and from school. The cost ranges from £572 to £644 per term depending on route. Please contact the Bursar's Office for further information.
Breakfast and tea clubs	allow parents and carers a flexible choice for drop off and collection. This is a pay as you go service and is billed at the end of each half term in arrears.
Breakfast/Tea club:	£6.00 per session.
After School Activities	If operated by a third party a cost will apply. A nominal cost for materials may apply in some cases.
Learning development LSA Support	£440 for one lesson a week per term for a 50 minutes lesson. £130 for one lesson a week per term for a 50 minute lesson.
EFL lessons	Tier 1 - £1280 per term Tier 2 - £770 per term Tier 3 - £525 per term
Flexi Boarding	We welcome pupils who wish to board on a part-time basis. The charge for this will be £49:00 per night. Please contact the Head of Boarding for further details.

OTHER INFORMATION

Registration and acceptance fees

For UK Residents a £100 non-refundable registration fee is required to register for a place at the school and a £250 deposit is required upon acceptance of a place. For International Residents a £250 non-refundable registration fee is required to register for a place at the school and a £1000 deposit is required upon acceptance of a place.

Scholarships and Bursaries

A small number of scholarships and bursaries as well as Military bursaries are offered by the School. **Please contact the Bursar's Office after registration.**

Payment options

Day and Boarding pupil fees can be paid termly or by an annual lump sum (with 3% discount). Monthly payments may be made through the School Fees Plan – please contact the Bursar's Office for details.

1. **Fees are payable in full before the first day of term.** Fees not paid by the 5th day will be surcharged at a rate of 1.5% on the 6th day and at 1.5% on the same date each subsequent month while the amount remains outstanding. Late payment of fees may lead to the exclusion of the pupil(s)
